### **Scholarship Outline 2016**

Student must be a United States citizen, a current senior attending a Stafford or Fauquier County high school that will be entering an accredited college/ university as a full-time, degree-seeking freshman in the fall of 2016. Applicants should also have demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular and/or other significant activities.

#### **\$500.00 Scholarship**

*Service Leadership Scholarship:* Awarded to (2) two students that have demonstrated innovative; initiative-driven leadership ability, both in and out of school impacting her/him academically and have done extraordinary work to strengthen their community. This work may deal with social issues, civic issues, address health or environmental concerns, or promote arts and humanities.

#### **\$1000.00 Scholarship**

*Academic Excellence Scholarship:* Awarded to a student who represents the holistic definition of overall excellence, one that transcends classroom performance. This award is designed to support students whose records reflect their commitment to:

- *Academic Excellence-* Students who have earned a grade point average of 85 on a 100-point scale, (an A on a letter scale or a 3.5 or better on a 4.0 scale).
- *Service and Leadership-* A student that is recognized for their leadership contributions going above and beyond the norm, while sustaining quality academic performance.
- *Community Engagement-* A student leader whose involvement and commitment has made significant contributions to their community and academic success.

#### **\$2000.00 Scholarship**

*Psi Psi Omega "ThinkHBCU" Scholarships:* Awarded to a student with the highest aggregate percentage in all contents every academic year, by having a cumulative 3.0 GPA or better and who will attend a Historically Black College or University (HBCU) and has demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular, or other significant activities.
