Call to order	Meeting was called to order by Andrea Hebert
Updates from STAC	Reviewed updates from STAC re: mentorship program, trauma billing EPIC report, peds readiness, clarification and classification info coming out for 3's and 4's to assist with PRQ, etc. Trauma Program 101 classes available, onboarding toolkit on DHS website https://www.dhs.Wisconsin.gov/publications/p03436.pdf Feedback L3/4's: Ensure you have a current PI plan, reach out to mentors re: under/over triage with use of Cribari and NFTI if need help to better understand.
Regional PI Guidelines	Reviewed and feel current guidelines cover it adequately, approved by group, good with proposed indicators added to document. Michael will let Margaret/group know we have reviewed and approved.
Data Reports	Reviewed indicators Q2 2023-Q1 2024 on Mortality by age, did note higher than state in age range > 65, may be r/t more older adults in our region vs south, Andrea to find data on ages across state. Michael to obtain data on this age group as well with injuries and/or ISS, possibly MOI. Reviewed Under and Over triage, no L3's or 4's on call today-would ask that anyone who is not meeting benchmark to reach out to L2's or mentors to assist if needing help on how to improve this. Unable to obtain report this month on MOI-will try for next mtg Reviewed data on Decision to tx and LOS. Believe that decision to tx may not have all data as this is optional field-something to be aware of. Noted for some patients with ISS > 15 decision to tx at 2 hours so id needing pt's to tx in < 3 hours, decision to tx needs to be made sooner. Andrea shared benchmarking document that shared decision to tx < 90 mins, revamp and share with group at future mtg for RTAC benchmark goal. Also request for Michael to try to drill down by ISS on tx out data as well as ID % of patients that are tx out of region.
MTP Drills	Rachel shared that Gina has included in NL mock traumas, also include feedback form with all MTP's to ID educational component. Also "trauma escape room" concept, may be useful for MTP drill i.e. do one or 2 steps and then get clue for next steps. Sara discussed that we typically cover in ICU/ED skills day, some discussion also with MCI drill.
