This is a controlled net that meets every Tuesday at 1900 hours on the 147.285 repeater. We ask that normal users of the repeater please stand by during the net.

If there is any emergency traffic, please indicate your presence by saying "BREAK, BREAK". The net will stand by until the emergency communication is completed or can be moved to another frequency. If you have or need information, break in with "INFO". If you'd like to make a contact, break in with "CONTACT."

The repeater has a positive offset and a PL of 151.4. All amateur operators are welcome to join in. - And we like to encourage any visitors, especially any new hams, to check in.

After I go through some standard club info I'll do a roll call of club members who usually check in; Then I'll ask for late or missed club members. Following that I'll ask for any guest check in's.
