

A Beautiful Death: The Decorated Nobles Tombs of Thebes

About this Event

Joanne has selected two New Kingdom Nobles tombs to talk about in depth. The tomb of Nakht (TT52) an official of the 18th dynasty, scribe and astronomer of Amun (likely during the reign of Thutmose IV) and the 19th dynasty tomb of Sa-Mut-Kyky (TT 409) an official during the time of Rameses 2.

Joanne will take an in depth look at these tombs explaining their purpose and how the painted decoration and grave goods guaranteed a successful after life for the tomb owner by depicting correct rituals and festivals for the tomb owner.

Joanne is a lecturer in Egyptology specialising in the material culture of ancient Egypt with a wide interest in the evolution of style throughout Pharaonic History.
