Important Instructions:

- **Do Not Eat or Drink** anything after midnight the night before your procedure.
- Avoid aspirin containing medication 5 days prior to procedure.
- Avoid anti-inflammatory medications such as Advil, Motrin, Aleve, ibuprofen and Excedrin. A list of medications to avoid is enclosed.
- If you are taking <u>ASPIRIN</u>, <u>COUMADIN or PLAVIX</u> prescribed by another physician, please consult with your cardiologist or primary care physician about discontinuing these 5 days prior to procedure. If you have any questions regarding specific medication, please call the prescribing doctor's office so they can advise you.
- For management of headaches or minor aches and pain, Tylenol may be taken up until the night before your scheduled procedure.
- You will need to make arrangements for transportation as you will be unable to drive yourself home. The amount of time that you will be there varies from two hours or more.

MoviPrep/OsmoPrep

A bowel prep is done to clear the bowel of all solid matter. Its purpose is to prepare the bowel for surgery or a procedure. Please follow these instructions. Begin the bowel prep one day before your scheduled procedure.

TO PREPARE

Tell your doctor if you have diabetes or take blood thinners. You may need to stop some of your medications a few days before your scheduled procedure.

THREE DAYS PRIOR TO THE PROCEDURE: Do not take iron pills or anti-inflammatory drugs (list provided). Coumadin is usually stopped 4 days prior to your procedure.

(DO NOT DISCONTINUE PRESCRIBED MEDICATION WITHOUT CONSULTING YOUR PHYSICIAN).

TWO DAYS PRIOR TO THE PROCEDURE: Try to eat a low residue diet (avoid seeds, popcorn, corn, fibrous vegetables). Discontinue fiber supplements such as Metamucil, Citrucel, Fibercon, etc.

ONE DAY PRIOR TO THE PROCEDURE:

- 1. Clear liquid diet only (see next page*). You may have a light breakfast.
- 2. Do not eat or drink anything after 12 midnight unless your procedure is scheduled after 12 noon the next day. You may gargle, but do not swallow any liquid. Do not smoke after 12 midnight.
- 3. Beginning at 6:00pm, take the first regimen as instructed.
- 4. At 11:00pm (or 5:00am the day of your procedure, <u>ONLY if</u> scheduled for 12 noon or later), take the second regimen as instructed.
- You will be receiving sedation for your procedure and must arrange for someone to escort you home
- You will not be able to drive yourself. If these arrangements have not been made, you procedure will need to be reschedule. This is a hospital (facility) requirement.
- The procedure and recovery time will take approximately 2 to 3 hours and you will need to arrive one hour prior to your scheduled procedure.
- If your insurance company requires a referral from your primary care physician or prior approval for the procedure, it is your responsibility to obtain this prior to your procedure.

Clear Liquid Diet

Soups: Clear Bouillon or Broth

Beverages: Tea, Coffee, Kool-Aid, Carbonated Beverages, Gatorade,

PowerAde. Do not use cream or milk in your coffee or tea.

Juices: Cranberry, Apple, Grape, Lemonade, Orange. (any drink you

can see through is acceptable, NO PULP).

Dessert: Ice, Italian Ice, Popsicles, Jell-O

• DO NOT TAKE THE FOLLOWING MEDICATIONS 5 DAYS PRIOR TO PROCEDURE UNLESS SPECIFIED BY YOUR PHYSICIAN.

• If you have any questions about medication that you are currently taking, please contact your physician before discontinuing.
