On each and every hawkker, the sum of \$10.00 per day, Every person who offers goods for sale by outcry on the street or shall conduct business from a stand and not have a permanent place of business within the village shall be deemed a hawkker under this ordinance.

Valley Light and Power Company \$20.07

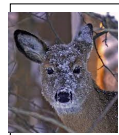

FUNDING DRINKING WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

We continue to seek additional funds from the Idaho Department of Commerce, the US Department of Agriculture Rural Development, and other agencies to reduce how much money we need to borrow to complete the needed improvements to allow the City the flexibility to complete the entire project if we do not receive additional funding.

Additional Funding Being Sought

- 12/12/22 DEQ Tech Approval for Water, Facility Planning Study
- 01/13/23 Submit letter of interest to DEQ for grant funding.
- 03/31/23 USDA Rural Development Facility Planning Study must meet environmental clearance to qualify for grant funding.
- 03/31/23 Public involvement for both DEQ and USDARD studies.

WINTER PARKING, SNOW and SLUSH REMOVAL

Are You Plowing Your Own Snow or Contracting?

Stake your boundary lines. 
Plow in straight lines, outward.
DO NOT plow or blow snow onto a neighbors property.
DO NOT plow or blow snow into a city street.

ROADS - Parking

The City of Cascade would like to remind you to keep the streets clear for snow removal operations.

Cascade City Code (7-2-2)

limits parking of motor vehicles on any street or alley within the City for a period of no longer than two (2) hrs.

SNOW / SLUSH -and MUD REMOVAL

Cascade City Code (5-7-1)

It is the responsibility of the Owners/Occupants of businesses fronting Main St. to remove snow, slush and mud from the sidewalks within 24 hours of occurrence.
