

HEALTH GUARANTEE

Cash Setters wants both you and your new puppy to thrive as a team both in the home and in the pursuit of upland game. In order for that to happen we need to give your puppy the best possible start we can to life throughout its development-physically, mentally, emotionally and physiologically. Please follow these guidelines and have the confidence that you have done everything you can to grow your Cash pup into a sound healthy adult.

Owner requirements

The guidelines listed below must be followed to maintain the three-year health guarantee provided by Cash Setters.

- 1. Puppy will not be allowed to use stairs/steps until five months of age.
- 2. All puppy vaccines will be spaced at least two weeks apart and only given in single vaccine at a time.
- 3. Puppy will receive a total of (3) distemper/parvo vaccines including what was given by Cash Setters vaccines. Given one yearly after a year of age.
- 4. Puppy will need to be put on tick preventative from local vet.
- 5. Puppy will receive its rabies vaccine after other vaccinations and after age of 16wks. Puppy will need to be fed a high kibble and or raw diet. Kinetic 30k is what your puppy will be on when picking up your puppy from Cash Setters.
- 6. Puppy will not be walked more than 20 minutes on hard surfaces (pavement, concrete, brick and gravel roads) until the age of 5 months
- 7. Puppy will not be taken on hikes exceeding 15 minutes between 2-3 months of age. Hikes will not exceed 20 minutes between 3-4 months of age. Hikes will not exceed 40 minutes between 4-5 months of age. Hikes will not exceed 60 minutes between 5-6 months of age. Hikes will not exceed 90 minutes between 6-8 months of age. Hikes will not exceed 120 minutes between 8-12 months of age. Over 12 months of age there is no exercise restrictions. Yard time from the time you bring your pup home is totally fine, as your pup can choose to rest whenever it needs to and is on a soft surface.
- 8. Pup must be checked by vet yearly, on heartworm preventive monthly year around.
- 9. Spay or Neuter- for females your puppy must have had her first heat cycle or hit 16 months of age. Males 16 months of age can be altered.
