Lot Maintenance

The governing documents of the HOA require all homeowners to maintain their lots in a manner that is consistent with the general appearance of the neighborhood. This includes mowing grass regularly (grass is not to be taller then 6"), keeping lawns free of weeds (apply treatments if necessary), pruning shrubs, removing dead trees, storing trash totes in the garage (or at least up next to the house, not at the curb), painting trim, replace torn window screens, and power washing siding. In the last couple of years the algae build up on the North facing elevations has become significant. The algae can be easily removed by power washing. Keeping your home and lot maintained will assist with the overall desirability of the neighborhood and increase property values.
