

HARRY K. NIESCHULZ

1906-1985



Harry Karl Nieschulz, age 78, of St George, Utah, formerly of the Pigeon area, passed away Wednesday, Jan 16 at Dixie Medical Center, following a heart attack

He was born Sept 19, 1906 in Pigeon to Heinrich Fredrich and Maria Helene Elise Meyer Nieschulz. He

married Mary Landry Nov 20, 1936 in Lake Charles, La. Their marriage was solemnized in the Mesa Temple in October, 1965.

Mr. Nieschulz was reared on a farm at Pigeon. He later purchased and operated a farm in Caseville. In 1949 he moved to Chandler, Ariz. and operated a dairy farm, later moving to Casa Grande, Ariz., where he owned and operated a motel and grocery store. He came to St. George, Utah in 1978.

An active member of the church, he served as a Stake Missionary, worked in the genealogical library for two years and in the extraction program for six years. He also served as a secretary and teacher of his priesthood quorum.

He is survived by his wife, Maria, a son, Nelson Harry Nieschulz of Phoenix, Ariz., a daughter, Mrs. Weldon (Carmen) Sudweeks of St. George and eight grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Jan 19 in the St. George Latter Day Saints Second Ward Chapel. Interment was in the St. George City Cemetery.
