

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

TOWN OF KREMMLING
SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING
July 28, 2020

The Board of Trustees, for the Town of Kremmling, met in the boardroom located at 200 Eagle Avenue. Mayor Grover Pryor called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Due to COVID-19, this meeting was held via Zoom. Trustees present: Jim Miller, Jason Wikberg, Leo Pesch, Dave Sammons, and Erik Woog. Staff present: Town Manager Dan Stoltman, Interim Police Chief Annette Dopplick, and Town Clerk Joanna Eaton. Absent: Trustee Holly Martinson

There were no citizen comments.

Discussion and Action on Placing a Gallagher Stabilization Ballot question for the November Election - Mayor Pryor mentioned that the State, County, and, Fire District will plan on having the Gallagher ballot question on their ballots in November. Trustee Woog strongly believes that this would be very important for Kremmling to have on the ballot and hopefully it will pass. The Board agreed to see it on the Town's ballot this November and directed Manager Stoltman to bring a final ballot question to the Board at the next meeting.
