

FALL 2013 SEASON TEAM INFORMATION

LEAGUE RULES

A complete set of ISL rules is available online. It is important that you read and understand every rule.

LINE-UP GAME CARDS and PLAYER PASSES

Each team must bring their US Youth Soccer member passes signed by an official registrar of Indiana Soccer, and two (2) copies of an their OFFICIAL ISL LINE-UP GAME CARDS printed from your GOTSOCCER team account to every match. Player passes will be checked at the start of each game by the referee. After the players have been checked in, the passes are to be returned to the team. There is no need for the referee to retain any pass for any reason since "red card" player passes are no longer sent to the league administrator.

REFEREE FEES

Referees are only paid for the position they are to work. EX: If an AR does not show, the teams provide a club linesman to assist the certified referees and the teams keep the monies for the missing referee. The club linesman is not paid. The other referees do not keep and split the missing referee's fees.

SEND OFFS AND SUSPENSIONS

Team managers and coaches are expected to self-enforce all suspensions. On all Send Offs and expulsions, the player, coach, or team official, must not participate in that team's next scheduled ISL game. A team that plays an ineligible player shall be subject to disciplinary action including, but not limited to: forfeiture of the match, suspension of the team's coach from ISL competition, or expulsion of the team from the ISL.

SEVERE WEATHER GAME CHANGES/CANCELLATIONS

All weather related game information will be posted on the ISL webpage, emailed to the team coach and manager of record, sent via text message to those who have set it up in their accounts, and phone calls made to teams starting with those traveling the farthest distance. There is also an ISL HOTLINE that will be updated: 1-317-829-0560 EXT 105. NOTE: A closed field does not equal a cancelled game. We try first to relocate the game if possible. You will be notified either way if your team is affected.

GAME CHANGES-FORFEITS

After the final schedule is released, every game change request will incur a \$100 fee payable to Indiana Soccer and due immediately to the league. Every game that is forfeited will incur a \$300 fine payable to Indiana Soccer and due immediately to the league. Any game change request or forfeit within 48 hours of game time kickoff will also incur an additional fine equal to the amount of the full cost of the referee fees for the age group.
