DESCRIPTION: This is a restored 1958 +/-Bear Polar. It was stripped and refinished. I saved and touched up the original logos although they are only in fair condition. New buckskin leather grip, new rug rest and leather side plate. This old gal still shoots really well. It's a fun bow to shoot if you like the old style long bows. This is a semi-recurve but would quality as a longbow under NFAA rules as the string does not touch the limbs when strung. Hard Maple riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Polar Ice tip overlays. Tips are in great condition. Note: the original overlays were missing, so I added polar white micarta tip overlays. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No crazing. A few minor stress lines, scratches and nicks here and there. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Comes with a new rug rest and side plate as shown, and a new Dacron string.

This bow sold for \$32.50 in 1958, which translates to \$347 in 2024 inflation adjusted dollars.
