DATES TO REMEMBER

Saturdays at Bone Voyage Pet Resort (Harborside Drive):

Basic Obedience- 3, 10, 17, 24 May, 10-11am, \$150

In this class we will cover sit, down, loose leash walking, stay, come, off, leave it and a "fun trick" behavior. We will also cover health and grooming topics and on leash socialization exercises.

Intermediate Obedience- 3, 10, 17, 24 May, 11-12pm, \$150

In this class we go past the basics with longer sit and down stays, meeting and greeting strange people and strange dogs, desensitization to equipment such as wheelchairs, walkers, crutches, and more. We provide a higher distraction environment to work on recalls and so much more. This is a stand alone class, but also doubles as a prep class for anyone who wants to take the AKC Canine Good Citizen or Delta Society Pet Partner evaluations.

Sundays at Galveston Vet Clinic (61st Street):

Basic obedience- 27 April, 4, 11, 18, 25 May, 4-5pm, \$150
