Memorial services were held Wednesday, Oct. 25, in Trinity United Methodist Church, Sebewaing, for Mrs. Clarence (Ruth) Terrill, 70, of 1778 Unionville Road, Bay Port, who passed away Oct. 23 at Bay Medical Center, following a long illness.

The Rev. E.D.K. Isaacs officiated and burial was in Memorial Park Cemetery. Dinkel Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

She was born May 25, 1908 in Sebewaing, the daughter of William F. and Emma (Hornbacher) Gettel. She graduated in 1925 from Sebewaing High School and was also a graduate of Michigan State College receiving a masters degree in education.

On Sept. 18, 1933, she and Clarence Terrill were united in marriage.

Mrs. Terrill served as director of food services at the YWCA in Flint for 10 years. In 1945, the family moved to the Sebewaing and Bay Port area, where Mrs. Terrill served as Home Economics teacher in the Sebewaing and Unionville School systems for approximately 20 years, retiring in 1965.

Mrs. Terrill was a member of Trinity Church United Methodist Women, Order of Eastern Star No. 407 and Speedy 66 Farm Bureau group.
