MACA! Make Advent about Christ Again! ~ WWJW? What Would Jesus Want?

Medjugorje Message from Our Blessed Mother on Nov 25, 2024: "Dear Children, In this time of the grace of expectation, I desire to call you to prayer for advent to be prayer of the family. Sin a special way little children whom I tenderly embrace, I encourage you to prayer for peace in the world, for peace to prevail over peacelessness and hatred."

1. Let's take a virtual trip to the tiny village of Nazareth! What if you ran into Mary & Joseph at the market in Nazareth on Jesus' 15th Birthday & they invited you to come celebrate with them? What would we learn?

*What if we asked - what have they been doing for the last month to prepare for this celebration?

- We've been asking Jesus what He wants for **HIS** birthday!
- Frequent retelling of stories about His birth & early life (Joyful rosary mysteries, Joseph's dreams, etc.)
- Making pilgrimages to some of these important sites of His life even visiting cousin John & Elizabeth
- Hosting special meals with friends and family to commemorate these stories
- Keeping holy the Sabbath by reading the Torah together, Singing and Praising God for His gift to us

*What if we asked - How are you all going to celebrate this amazing day? The birth of your son and our savior!

- Planned a special FEAST with friends and family
- To spend intentional, meaningful, loving face to face time with Jesus!
- Share why we love Jesus & our favorite personal memories of Him
- Read the Torah, Sing Praises and thanking God the Father for sending Him to us
- Our gifts for Him are planning special trips fishing, camping, eating together for the next year
- 2. **How can we make Advent all about Jesus!** What can we learn for them on how to prepare for Jesus' Birthday! *Realize the difference between preparation time (Advent) and Jesus' Birthday its not over on Dec. 25th!
 - Look at how Mary & Joseph might have prepared above and convert to 2024 traditions
 - a. Collection of Advent ideas on back to ponder Lovingly offered to Jesus lots of links with resources
 - b. Have family meal to focus on Preparing our Hearts, Homes and Families for the arrival of Jesus
 - What we have done in the past that kept Christ in the forefront of the season:
 - a. Prayed the <u>Advent Wreath</u>, Set out Nativity Sets & Bethlehem Village, Organized <u>Service</u> Projects, <u>Drew names</u> for Secret Santas (Kris Kringle), Gift Swap Game w/ Jesus gifts, Caroling, Gave presents to Jesus, attended Advent events, confession, focus on experiences/time together instead of gifts, made <u>handmade</u> religious gifts...
 - What we are going to add this year and make new traditions to prepare for His arrival:
 - a. Set up the nativity set and move Mary, Joseph and three kings each day straw for manger idea
 - b. Prepare our Kitchen table to be centralized prayer space for nightly reflections
 - c. Eat family meals at table each night ~ <u>light Advent wreath</u> & pray; <u>celebrate saint feast days</u> consider unplugged candle lit Nazareth Meals (olives, dates, nuts, bread, wine) to retell stories of Jesus
 - d. Add fasting days (M,W,F) deciding what to offer up & turn our phone screens to greyscale till Christmas
 - e. Pick "Christ Kindl" Advent Angels with different groups and do secret sacrifices and prayers for them reveal later
 - f. Turn our tree into a Jesse tree and read readings put on other ornaments later in season
 - g. Make new prayer traditions Daily Angelus, Christmas Novena, O Antiphons, put bible on kitchen table...
- 3. How can we celebrate His birth from Dec 25th thru Feb 2nd Candlemas?
 - What we have done in the past that kept Christ in the forefront of the season:
 - Christmas morn tradition of <u>reading the birth story from Luke</u>, Singing Happy Birthday to Baby Jesus then breakfast and gifts, 9pm New Years Celebration & <u>resolutions</u>, Generate <u>words</u>, <u>Saints</u>, virtues and spiritual goals for the year to focus on – make new habits, Epiphany <u>marking of our doors</u>, an annual <u>Dance</u> party, then taking down decor
 - What we are going to add this year and make new traditions to celebrate His birth after Dec. 25th:
 - i. "Pray" the <u>12 Days of Christmas</u>
 - ii. Focus on Feast Days (Christmas Solemnities) and turning them into holy moments with our family
 - iii. Start new traditions like weekly Zoom prayer call with extended family
 - iv. Learn more about Candlemas Feb. 2nd and how to celebrate them
- 4. Your turn! What will you give Jesus this year? Take the Birthday Challenge just pick a few don't overwhelm yourself ask yourself What does Jesus Want From YOU? What are you willing to Give Him December 25th and the whole year through... Take some time to ponder these, write a letter to Jesus for His birth & share face to face in adoration

From December 1st to the 24th we FAST/Prepare for His birth.... Then we FEAST/Celebrate for 40 days to Feb 2nd!
