

HENRY C. BLASI

1901-1993

Henry C. Blasi, 92 of Owendale, died Wednesday, Nov. 3, in Huron County Medical Care Facility, Bed Aaa, following a lengthy illness.

Mr. Blasi was born in Brookfield Township on April 30, 1901, the son of George and Ida (Behm) Blasi. He was married to Frieda Woldt on Sept. 5, 1926, in Kilmanagh, and she survives him.

Mr. Blasi had farmed in the Owendale area for many years before retiring 22 years ago. He was a lifelong member of St. John Lutheran Church, Kilmanagh, where he had served as an elder and on the cemetery committee. He was a member of Wotton Farm Bureau.

Surviving, besides his wife Frieda are three daughters, Mrs. Albertus (Ruth A.) Ghiotti of Bay Port, Lucille DeFiske and Mrs. Donald (Jean) Runcell, both of Sebawaing, 11 grandchildren, 25 great-grandchildren, four great-great-grandchildren, one sister, Ottilie Gaeth of Sebawaing, and several nieces and nephews.

One sister, Amanda Menzel, preceded Mr. Blasi in death.

The funeral service took place at 11 a.m. Saturday in St. John Church, Kilmanagh with Rev. Jeffrey Walsh officiating. Burial was in the church cemetery. Dinkel-Juengel Funeral Home, Sebawaing, was in charge of funeral arrangements.
