
**\*Teacher Recommendation for GED-Ready®**

12 hours

- Teacher recommends GED-Ready®?
- Take GED-Ready® in your first choice of subject.



Score 145+ on  
GED-Ready®?

- Earn state scholarship.
- Take GED® in that subject. Score 145+ to pass that test.



Repeat  
process

- Take GED-Ready® in second choice subject. Score 145+ to earn scholarship. Repeat process. If you score less than 145, complete remediation in that subject and retake GED-Ready®.
- After 2nd GED® test, post-test and make NRS gain on TABE to earn more scholarships. If you don't make an NRS gain, you must score 148+ on GED-Ready® to earn scholarships for third and fourth subjects.
