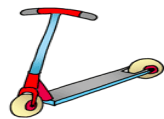
Home delivered meals

A hot, well-balanced lunch is available daily to senior shut-ins living in Morrow County. Weekend and holiday frozen meals are also available upon request. A suggested donation of \$3.00 per meal is accepted.



Lunch at Seniors on Center

A hot lunch is served daily at 11:45 a.m. Reservations are required by calling the Center at least 24 hours in advance. A suggested donation of \$3.00 is accepted for those 60+ and a charge of \$5.00 for those under 60.



Transportation

Handicapped accessible transportation and escort service to work, doctor appointments, beauty shop, grocery shopping, social activities, therapy, etc. is available. Please call 24 hours ahead for an appointment. A suggested donation of \$3.00 is accepted. Transportation for medical appointments outside the county can usually be arranged with a 48 hour notice.

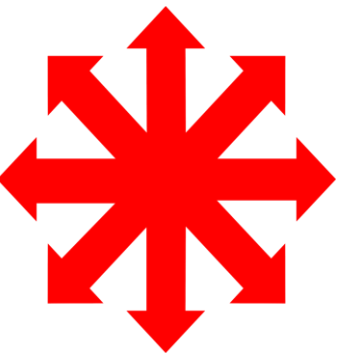

## MOTHER'S DAY DESSERT

### CHOCOLATE SILK PIE

**TOTAL TIME:** Prep: 30 min. + chilling **YIELD:** 6-8 servings

#### INGREDIENTS:

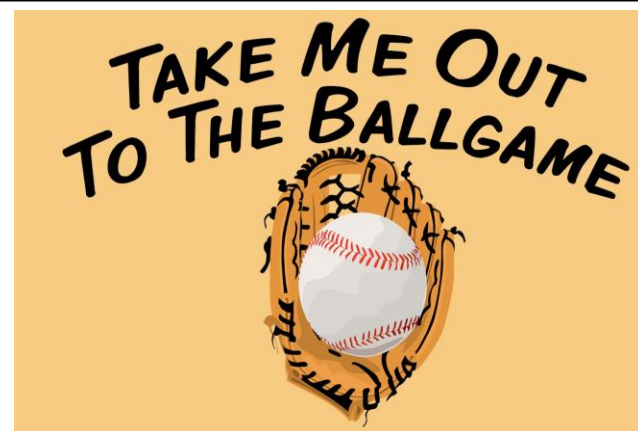
1 unbaked pastry shell (9 inches) • 1 jar (7 ounces) marshmallow creme  
1 cup (6 ounces) semisweet chocolate chips • 1/4 cup butter, cubed  
2 ounces unsweetened chocolate • 2 tablespoons strong brewed coffee  
1 cup heavy whipping cream, whipped

#### TOPPING:

1 cup heavy whipping cream  
2 tablespoons confectioners' sugar  
Chocolate curls, optional

#### DIRECTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 450°. Line unpricked pastry shell with a double thickness of heavy-duty foil. Bake 8 minutes. Remove foil; bake 5 minutes. Cool on a wire rack.
2. Meanwhile, in a heavy saucepan, combine marshmallow creme, chocolate chips, butter, unsweetened chocolate and coffee; cook and stir over low heat until chocolate is melted and mixture is smooth. Cool. Fold in whipped cream; pour into crust.
3. For topping, in a large bowl, beat cream until it begins to thicken. Add confectioners' sugar; beat until stiff peaks form. Spread over filling. Refrigerate at least 3 hours before serving. Garnish with chocolate curls if desired. Yield: 6-8 servings.
