Amos describes the luxurious living of his time and blames the wealthy for not caring about the collapse of Joseph. Like Israel [Jacob] and Judah, Joseph is one of the Jewish patriarchs, their names are often used just to indicate God’s people. The “woe of this message is addressed as God’s word to the wealthy of all times and cultures. The Lord “gives food to the hungry,” but he needs our hands to distribute it (Responsorial Psalm).

Her eyes were opened: “I did not know that such poverty existed right here!” In the Gospel, we read that the rich man's eyes were opened too late! Abraham told his nephew Lot to live luxuriously: “[You] have Moses and the prophets with you.”
