



Ranking/Evaluation

1. **Policy Statement:** SABOA members will be ranked/evaluated and skill set (Tier) determined to aid their advancement in every practical way to the highest levels of officiating the game of basketball.
2. **Procedure:** Members may attend a SABOA scheduled Ranking/Evaluation session:
 - a) GASO San Antonio Tournament
 - b) San Antonio high school Fall Leagues
3. **Criteria:** Members will be ranked/evaluated using criteria set forth by the Executive Committee. An established rubric shall be used by evaluators in the conduct of the ranking/evaluation.
 - a) Appearance, Mobility and Physical Fitness
 - b) Communication with Coaches and Co-officials
 - c) Knowledge and Application of Rules
 - d) Attitude and Professionalism
 - e) Court Presence
 - f) Floor Leadership
 - g) Game Management
 - h) High Call Accuracy and Call Selectivity
 - i) Demonstrated capability within 2-person and/or 3-person mechanics
4. **Ranking Tiers:** Ranking Tiers are assigned on evaluations and criteria met. Officials who do meet the established criteria annually shall be considered “**not in good standing**”. playoffs.
 - a) **100** – eligible to work any level of game:
 - 1) Chapter’s Top 15%
 - 2) HIGHEST proficiency **demonstrated per ALL areas of proficiency rating criteria**
 - 3) Crew Chief and able to work any game assignment
 - 4) Advanced UIL and State/Regional Level Assignment Ready
 - 5) Required to attend or critique a SABOA once every two years to remain
 - 6) All test scores 90+ and in good standing
 - 7) Must participate in at least 2 scrimmages
 - 8) Work at least 25 Varsity assignments
 - 9) Attend at least 3 Chapter meetings (Christmas Social is considered a meeting)

- 10) Required to attend or critique at SABOA camps once every two years to remain
 - 11) Work at least one junior high game assignment with a 500 ranked official
- b) **200** – eligible to work playoff games and below:
- 1) Chapter Top 25-30%
 - 2) Crew Chief/U1 for most assignments
 - 3) Above average proficiency per most areas of ranking criteria
 - 4) Eligible for all levels during playoffs
 - 5) Attend camp as a camper or clinician every two years
 - 6) Eligible for all levels during playoffs
 - 7) All test scores 90+ and in good standing
 - 8) Must participate in at least 2 scrimmages
 - 9) Work at least 25 Varsity assignments
 - 10) Attend the SABOA evaluation/ranking every 2 years
 - 11) Attend at least 3 Chapter meetings (Christmas Social is considered a meeting)
 - 12) Work at least one junior high game assignment with a 500 ranked official
- c) **300** – eligible to work high school games and could be considered for playoffs
- 1) Chapter's Top 50% List, including up and coming officials (Top Campers)
 - 2) Average to above average demonstration of most areas of ranking criteria
 - 3) Above average proficiency within 3-person mechanics system
 - 4) Attends **camp** EVERY year – three person mechanics camp
 - 5) All test scores 90+ and in good standing
 - 6) Attend the SABOA evaluations/ranking every 2 years
 - 7) Attend at least 3 Chapter meetings (Christmas Social is considered a meeting)
 - 8) Work at least one junior high game assignment with a 500 ranked official
- d) **400** – eligible to work lower level high school games (3A and lower) and below
- 1) Some Proficiency Skill in 3 Person Mechanics
 - 2) High Proficiency for 2 person Crew Chief for sub varsity games and below
 - 3) Crew Chief - Post Season JV, Freshman, Middle School Tournaments
 - 4) Attends SABOA Camp EVERY year, three person mechanics camp

- 5) All test scores 80+ and in good standing
 - 6) Attend any referee camp every 2 years (Advanced 2-person training is considered a camp)
 - 7) Attend at least 3 Chapter meetings (Christmas Social is considered a meeting)
 - 8) Work at least one junior high game assignment with a 500 ranked officials
- e) **500** – Eligible to work sub varsity and below:
- 1) Med-High Proficiency Skills - 2 person mechanics
 - 2) Eligible for Post Season Middle School Tournaments
 - 3) Attends Camp EVERY year, 2 person, some 3 person
 - 4) All test scores 70+ and in good standing
 - 5) Attend at least 3 Chapter meetings (Christmas Social is considered a meeting)
- f) **600** – Unranked Officials
- 1) New official without any experience
 - 2) Transfer officials (have not been evaluated and given a rating level)
- g) **700** – Not Ranked Officials. These official decided not to be ranked
