First Lesson 1 Kings 1:28-35 [28](#) Then King David answered and said, "Call Bathsheba to me." So she came into the king's presence and stood before the king.[29](#) And the king took an oath and said, "As the Lord lives, who has redeemed my life from every distress,[30](#) just as I swore to you by the Lord God of Israel, saying, 'Assuredly Solomon your son shall be king after me, and he shall sit on my throne in my place,' so I certainly will do this day."[31](#) Then Bathsheba bowed with her face to the earth, and paid homage to the king, and said, "Let my lord King David live forever!"[32](#) And King David said, "Call to me Zadok the priest, Nathan the prophet, and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada." So they came before the king.[33](#) The king also said to them, "Take with you the servants of your lord, and have Solomon my son ride on my own mule, and take him down to ihon."[34](#) There let Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet anoint him king over Israel; and blow the horn, and say, 'Long live King Solomon!'[35](#) Then you shall come up after him, and he shall come and sit on my throne, and he shall be king in my place. For I have appointed him to be ruler over Israel and Judah."

Second Lesson 1 Corinthians 9:24-27 [24](#) Do you not know that those who run in a race all run, but one receives the prize? Run in such a way that you may obtain it.[25](#) And everyone who competes for the prize is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a perishable crown, but we for an imperishable crown.[26](#) Therefore I run thus: not with uncertainty. Thus I fight: not as one who beats the air.[27](#) But I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest, when I have preached to others, I myself should become disqualified.
