The Vestry met on September 7, 2016. Agenda items included: buildings and grounds updates; information on our recent garage sale fundraiser; and the report from Reverend Holly Eden on the meetings she conducted with us. In addition, a new Warden was appointed.

Year to date income is \$38,346, which includes funds donated towards our capital projects as well as outreach income. Year to date expenses are \$34,986. The expenses also include capital improvements as well as funds used for outreach.
