Thayer Extreme Guidelines...

These are different days, and in an effort to stay safe and ensure everyone feels as comfortable as possible, here are some guidelines we would like to follow for the weekend...

- Practice social distancing – 6 feet apart
- Leave 10 feet between vehicles
- Riders Only in the sign-up line (minors can have a guardian)
- Bring your own pen
- Print the entry form that is posted on-line and bring it with you to sign-up (filled out)
Every rider must fill out an entry form, even if you raced with us at Rd1
- Print the gate form that is posted on-line and bring it with you (filled out)
- Bring exact change to gate & sign-up (study fees posted on-line/on the entry form)
- Please bring a clean helmet to sign-up
- Riders Meeting(s) will be on the starting line
- Riders are only allowed 1 support person in the starting area
- Please keep away from the scoring area
- There will be NO trophy presentation(s). Trophies will be available for pick-up at Round 2. Prior to Round 2 there will be a list posted on-line of trophy winners so you'll know if you have one coming.

Again, things are different these days & we are trying to do our part. Thanks for your understanding.

This weekend is Round 2 of the MORE series at Thayer Extreme. Last year's event was a favorite among our riders, and we expect this one to be even better.

The property owner (Rick – Iron Dog) has reclaimed some old forgotten single track and has also created some brand-new stuff for us.

He has been hard at work on the motocross track and has mixed load after load of sawdust in with the dirt to increase traction. Wait until you see his state-of-the-art mountain man watering system!!

We will run the course in the opposite direction from last year, but with some planning, drawing, arguing, and re-routing, we will run the moto section in the proper direction (minus the 2 big jumps).

All courses are a bit longer than last year which means everyone gets some new trail.

50 course will have their own trail and start area with green ribbon & orange/black arrows.

65/Ladies/85 start on the motocross track and follow purple ribbon & orange/black arrows. Two new sections of trail on this course.

Sportsman race is blue arrows – some new stuff – some old flowy stuff – all fun stuff.

Extra trail for Sunday – maybe another 1 ½ miles – 1/3 is brand-new.

Moto track is safe – not jumpy – freshly raked and will be watered whether Mother Nature does it or we do.

Concessions available...please support their efforts.

Sign up before you practice – respect the facility – NO riding after dark.

For first-timers to MORE, please take a minute to read through our Rules, and look over our Classes/Numbering lists. Every series does things a little differently than others, so it's important that prior to race day that you are informed. One thing to note is that riders are required to display the appropriate number and background color on all three number plates during our events. If you don't have the correct setup, generics are available at signup for \$3/set of three.

Please make sure that your pets are on a leash at ALL times and remain at your vehicle.

Directions – From Thayer, take Hwy 63 north to Hwy 19. Turn right and go 6 miles to Hwy A. Turn right and go 2 miles. Race entrance on the right.
