

**PUBLIC HEARING
AGRICULTURAL SECURITY PROPOSAL – DIANE RUDELITCH
FEBRUARY 25, 2019 AT 6:45PM**

Polk Township Supervisors Brian K. Ahner, Carl S. Heckman, & Michael D. Hurley met for a Public Hearing on Monday, February 25, 2019 at 6:45 pm at the Municipal Building, 165 Polk Twp. Rd., Kresgeville, PA. Solicitor James V. Fareri, Engineer Russell R. Kresge, Jr., Zoning/Codes Official Justin Burkner & Treasurer Beverly A. Christman were also present. Residents present included: Jonathan Shupp, Harold Touni, Jr., Robert Butler, Robert Andre, and Jack Kondratick.

Court Reporter Donna Kenderline was present to record the Public Hearing.

Chariman Ahner opened the Hearing and asked Solicitor Fareri to officiate.

Fareri stated Diane Rudelitch, living at 163 Beltzville Dr., Kunkletown, PA, has made application to enter two parcels into the Polk Township Agricultural Security Area. The parcels are: 13/12/1/30-1 with 15.50 acres and 13/12/1/31 with 14.17 acres. Exhibits were named.

- The required initial Notice of the Application Proposal placed in the Pocono Record on January 23, 2019.
- The required Public Hearing Notice placed in the Pocono Record on February 8 & 15, 2019.
- A list of neighboring property owner's addresses, to which, both notices were sent with cover letter and map of both parcel locations.


Exhibit # 2 includes:
