- 1. Directory 5 man gov't
- 2. 1796 made Napoleon military leader
- 3. 1798-99 invaded Egypt found Rosetta Stone
- 4. Rosetta Stone key to deciphering hieroglyphics
- 5. 1799 stage a coup d'etat to overthrow the gov't
- 6. Napoleon became the first consul of France

II. Napoleon's Rule

- 1. Created the Napoleonic Code, system of laws for internal problems
- 2. Equality to men
- 3. Fair tax code
- 4. National bank and currency
- 5. Created lycées, public high schools
- 6. Normalized relations with the Church
- 7. Limited role of women
- 8. Still used today

III Napoleon's Empire

- 1. Napoleon's goal was to build an empire
- 2. Napoleon's troops conquer Austria, Prussia, Spain, Portugal, and some of Italy
- 3. Destroyed the Holy Roman Empire
- 4. 1803 organized German States
- 5. Sold Louisiana to the United States
- 6. 1804 crowned himself emperor
- 7. 1810 empire at its peak

IV The Fall

1. 1812 controlled most of Europe (except GB, Sweden and Ottoman Empire)
