INDUSTRY NEWS: BelliWelli, gut-healthy snacks, raised \$10M from Invus. Cristiano Ronaldo made a significant investment in personalized supplement maker Bionig. Bee-free honey producer MeliBio has received a strategic investment from Future Food Fund, the venture arm of Japanese food

distributor Oisix. Non-alcoholic craft beer company Best Day Brewing reports raising \$22.5M this year. Splash Beverage Group (Salt Tequila & Tapout) raised an undisclosed amount through a private placement to help fund an acquisition. Rarebird Coffee, caffeine-infused coffee products, raised \$1M from undisclosed investors. Hello Soju, RTD soju cocktails, raised \$5M. Meili Vodka raised \$4M from undisclosed investors. MicroLub, fat replacements for plant-based foods, raised £3.5M led by Northern Gritstone, with Praetura Ventures & LIFTT involved. Molly Sims' Yse Beauty received an undisclosed investment from Willow Growth Partners. Jüsto, Latin America eCommerce grocer, raised \$70M with \$50M in equity led by General Atlantic & \$20M debt arranged by HSBC México. Stellapps Technologies, contract manufacturing & private label dairy, raised \$26M from Blume Ventures, Omnivore, IDH Farmfit Fund, 500 Startups, Blue Ashva Capital & Miledeep Capital. Simbe Robotics (Tally robots) raised \$50M led by Goldman Sachs with participation from Eclipse, Valo Ventures & existing investors. FarmDroid, autonomous, solar-powered agricultural robot, raised €10.5M led by Convent Capital, with participation from EIFO & Navus Ventures. Carbon Robotics raised a \$70M Series D to expand its autonomous LaserWeeder platform, led by BOND with participation from NVentures (NVIDIA's venture arm), Anthos Capital, Fuse Venture Capital, Ignition Partners, Revolution, Sozo Ventures & Voyager Capital. Courageous Land, a Brazilian agroforestry-tech company, closed an investment led by Fundo Vale, Seedstars International Ventures & The Yield Lab Latam, with JLL Foundation, Wedgetail & others involved. Blue Evolution & Blu3 merged to use their technologies to expand sustainable seaweed innovation. Chipotle made a minority investment in fast-casual restaurant Brassica. KDP will acquire Ghost sports nutrition & energy in two phases, with KDP paying \$990M for a 60% stake & then acquiring the rest in 2028 based on Ghost's 2027 financial performance. Second Nature Brands will acquire the Voortman cookies from J.M. Smucker for \$305M including a plant & workers; reports say Smucker remains committed to Hostess & its other sweet bakery offerings. JAB will buy Mondelez's Stake in JDE Peet's for €2.16B. AUA sold Raymundo's Food Group, a Hispanic-inspired snack brand, to Lakeview Farms. Cooper Brands acquired snack company Rusty's Chips. Innovative Food Holdings bought 100% of the assets of Golden Organics for \$1.75M in cash & debt. Tulkoff Food Products, horseradish & cocktail sauce, was acquired by investment firm Graham Partners. Pernod Ricard agreed to sell some of its Nordic brands (Lapponia, Minttu, Cederlunds Torr, Tapio & Marinella) to Hartwall. In Belgium, food manufacturer What's Cooking? sold its cold-meats business to Aurelius. Total Beverage Solution acquired three wine brands (Layer Cake, Cartlidge & Browne & Tamarack Cellars) from Vintage Wine Estates. Integrated Beverage Group acquired wine producer Firesteed Cellars. Forever Cheese, cheese, cured meat & specialty foods importer, acquired Virginia Packing, cured meat slicing, packing & logistic services. Stratas Foods will acquire AAK Foodservice, a move to increase Stratas' presence in value-added oils, dressings, sauces & mayonnaise categories. Rethink Food acquired a fellow nonprofit, food box service Wellfare. Automation machinery manufacturer DSI Dantech acquired GEA Group's North American freezing business. To create a broader agtech digital data platform, Munters AB acquired Hotraco from the Dutch family office Nedvest.

Coca-Cola beat 3rd QTR EPS & revenue estimates on high prices & weak demand. *KDP* had a small revenue increase & a jump in 3rd QTR EPS; the company reaffirmed future guidance. *Unilever* bested 3rd QTR earnings. *Danone* reported comparable revenue growth of 4.2% in 3rd QTR due to price increases. *Starbucks* reported preliminary 4th QTR results showing a drop in revenue & foot traffic due to high prices & suspended its future guidance.

Amazon is changing its wholesale business model which may cause many small brands to transition to its consignment-style platform, known as Seller Central. Amazon is piloting a new small-format, quick-trip concept, Amazon Grocery, in Chicago near an existing Whole Foods Market store. Amazon Fresh is opening two stores on Long Island & one in Maryland. With the opening of our neighborhood Whole Foods Market in a new location, Amazon plans to utilize drone delivery! Publix opened six Florida stores in September & October. Kroger opened its first new store in North Texas since 2019. 7-Eleven will open over 600 large-format, food-focused convenience stores in North America by the end of 2027, with a more contemporary feel & a larger product assortment including expanded food, beverage & foodservice offerings. Nugget Markets broke ground on a 95K sq. ft. store in Rocklin, California. Jewel-Osco opened a new store in Diamond, IL. Walmart will offer pharmacy prescriptions & general merchandise in the same delivery order. Aldi plans to open around 20 new stores in Spain by the end of the year. Empire Company (Sobeys, FreshCo, Farm Boy & Longo's) will expand delivery with both Instacart & Uber Eats. Target plans to reduce regular prices on more than 2,000 private label & national brands this holiday season. Fresh Thyme will use Afresh's platform for stores to order food service products. GrubMarket will offer an AI-powered cash flow assistant for wholesalers & distributors. Applegate will introduce a frozen sausage on a stick wrapped in a pancake! Chosen Foods will launch an avocado oil-based shortening. Campbell will temporarily change the name of Goldfish crackers to Chilean Sea Bass to interest adults. Voyage Foods will open a 284K sq. ft. manufacturing facility in Mason, OH, with the capacity to make 10K metric tons of cocoa-free chocolate annually. Alianza Team, a supplier of lipids, fats & oils solutions, broke ground on its first USA facility in Goldsboro, NC. Vermont State University will build an on-campus meat plant. In New York, Hartwick College opened a baking innovation lab to assist small & mid-sized growers, bakers & food product developers of local cereals & grains. Denny's will close 150 locations, about 10% of its outlets. Simbe, maker of the autonomous, item-scanning robot Tally, has launched a real time shelflevel data intelligence platform, Simbe Brand Insights. Verdant Robotics unveiled the new 2025 Sharpshooter robotic weed killer. NotCo & Latin American flavor & fragrance company Cramer will partner to use Notco's AI product development platform to formulate fragrances. Tyson is under investigation for potential child labor violations at two plants in Arkansas. TreeHouse Foods recall due to the potential of listeria now includes frozen toaster waffles, Belgian waffles & pancake products produced at an Ontario plant. McDonald's reported e-Coli issues with its Quarter Pounders, likely from the slivered onions rumored to be tied to Taylor Farms; YUM! Brands & Burger King pulled onions from their menus

From *Brick Meets Click/Mercatus*, online grocery sales surged 14% YOY in 3rd QTR; all categories drove growth with delivery leading the results. In a survey, *Swiftly*, found that 70% of consumers still struggle with grocery affordability; 76% of shoppers use digital coupons & 72% still prefer shopping in-store. Per *Circana*, yogurt was the fastest growing dairy product, with end of September YOY sales growing 7% & totaling \$10.9B for the twelve-month period. Per *FMI*, plant-based store sales rose slightly to \$16.8B from \$16B in the twelve-month period ending in August, but plant-based dairy alternatives dipped from \$2.8B to \$2.6B. In an earth-shocking research study, the University of Arkansas for Medical Science found that 100% ground beef is more effective at building muscle than a soy-based counterpart. Pumpkin-flavored products cost an average of 7.4% more than non-pumpkin alternatives, according to *Lending Tree*. Per the USDA, dairy prices will remain as 2025 begins.

MARKET NEWS: Markets dropped early in the week as bond yields rose. The Nasdaq spent time in record territory & produced gains for the week, but the S&P & Dow ended lower. Continuing jobless claims were higher than estimated. September home sales hit a 14-year low. Sixty-one percent of parents believe their kids will never be able to afford a home.
