Art Contest

The Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development, Aviation Section, is proud sponsor the **2017 Louisiana Aviation Art Contest**, in cooperation with the Louisiana Managers and Associates (LAMA), and Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association (AOPA). It is our intent to motivate and encourage young people throughout Louisiana to become more familiar with and participate in aeronautics, engineering and science.

The theme for this year's contest is "**Beyond the Clouds.**" The artwork will be judged, at least in part, for its creative use of this year's theme in relation to the aviation world. Entries will be judged in six categories (determined by the age of the entrant on December 31, 2016). The categories are: **Age Groups are 6-7, 8-9, 10-11, 12-13, 14-15, and 16-17.** The top three winners from each category will then compete for the chance to advance to the National Association of State Aviation Officials (NASAO) Art Contest. Winners will receive age appropriate prizes.
