I don't know, care, or believe that God exists.
— a recent survey of young adults calls us to deeper commitment and greater witness as God's people.

"I don't know, care, or believe that God exists." — that was the answer given by 43% of young adults in a recent survey. And, no surprise, this same group also indicated they have growing intolerance for those with different opinions.

Only 48% of this group believes that you should "treat others as you want them to treat you." And 38% of them agree that "you should try to get even with people who have wronged you."

Meanwhile, many churches in America are carrying on with "business as usual," and doing very little to connect with this growing group of lost young adults all around us.

And, if we want to be selfish about it, we still have reason for concern. Our children and grandchildren will be growing up in the culture this group is creating, and those values are sure to affect them. They will be surrounded by these beliefs in their school classrooms, taught by teachers and professors, working for bosses and managers who are in that 43% and growing segment of our nation.

But our real motivation ought to be the tragedy of daily life not knowing Christ:

- not being sure of His love for us,
- not having that forgiveness that makes us innocent before God.
- not having the assurance that we have eternal life and the promise of heaven,
- not knowing our true value and purpose.

That's one of the reasons we know it's important to have Jon Britton on our staff, providing our students and children with a solid Christ-centered foundation for life.

But Jon can't do it alone. The staff can't do it for us. It will take our entire church being committed to doing **WHATEVER IT TAKES** to reach the young adults around us. Whatever it takes in worship, whatever it takes in outreach, whatever it takes in mission and service. Wherever we have to go, and whatever we have to do.

The Apostle Paul wrote to his friends in the church in Corinth:

I have made myself a slave to everyone, to win as many as possible. To the Jews I became like a Jew, to win the Jews. To those under the law I became like one under the law (though I myself am not under the law), so as to win those under the law. To those not having the law I became like one not having the law (though I am not free from God's law but am under Christ's law), so as to win those not having the law. To the weak I became weak, to win the weak. I have become all things to all people so that by all possible means I might save some. — 1 Corinthians 9:19-22

Will we, like Paul, become whatever we need to become to reach this increasingly lost generation, or will it be "business as usual"?
