NOTICE: Goulds Recreation is affiliated with Softball NL and follow their directions/guidelines for our minor softball program.

Below is a break down of the age categories offered this upcoming season.

Softball age categories: 7 and Under **Cost:** \$100 (1st child)

9 and Under \$95 (each additional child in same family)

11 and Under *Additional costs will be applicable

13 and Under for athletes who participate or compete

15 and Under in games/tournaments outside of our regular house program and/or for clinics

*Softball NL affiliation fee of \$30 (Insurance) is included in the cost of the program.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

House Program: 9-week program starting week of June 26th – June 29th. Each group will have a 1-1.5 hour session, twice a week during day times. 7U, 9U, 11U will also have Thursday evening game times. Depending on registration #'s, U13 may also have a Thursday evening game time. *The Info Package contains a tentative schedule. This may change due to registration numbers.*

Batting Cage time slots will also be available throughout the summer for age-appropriate groups. We are also hoping to be able to offer on-site clinics in various skill development areas.

**Tryouts: Will take place for certain age groups for teams to compete at tournaments. These tryouts usually take place towards the end of May and first part of June. Those trying out MUST be registered with our Minor Softball program.

This is a Pilot Program to gage interest.

This program is based off of the Active Start and Fundamental Movement Framework for children ages 2 to 5. The program will have a focus on coordination and balance. It will incorporate fundamental movements required to play various on land sports. This includes crawling, walking, running, skipping, jumping, kicking, throwing and catching. It will also incorporate a basic age appropriate introduction to basketball, tennis, softball and soccer.

How does it work? Every Friday at 4:30pm, an email will go out to our participant list with a link to the registration for the following Friday event. The link will be live as of Monday morning at 8am. *Monday's registration is for participants in at least 1 summer program ONLY*. After Monday registration, if there are remaining spots available, a link to register will be posted on our Facebook page on Tuesday, opening the event up to the public. The registration closes at 11:30pm on Tuesdays, or when spaces fill (whichever comes first). **SPACE IS LIMITED!** Payment confirms spot!

Time of Event: Will follow the same format as our Day Camp! Participants can be dropped off as early as 8am and picked up as late as 5:30pm! Drop-off and Pick-up are at the Rec Centre.

Cost: \$23/participant per event

**Your child will be participating with our Day Camp Participants on these Fridays. Number of spots we have available depends on the event planned. Including our day camp participants, we can have anywhere from 70+ participants on Fridays.

What will your child need to bring? Definitely a fully packed lunch and snacks (no refrigeration or heating on site), plenty to drink (reusable water bottles are ideal), Sun Screen, and proper clothing/footwear for the day (a change of clothes would not be a bad idea!). Ensure to label all belongings!

Children registered in our Day Camp program are already registered for the Friday events that fall on their weeks at Day Camp.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

All summer registration is completed on-line through Eventbrite. The Registration links for the various programs will be posted on our Facebook Page – Goulds Recreation and on our Website – www.gouldsrecreation.com. If you have difficulty accessing the registration, please try refreshing the link. We cannot take registration over the phone. Payment is not made through our on-line registration. For all programs, with the exception of Day Camp, fees will be due 2 weeks prior to program start date. Payment holds your child's spot for the program.

DAY CAMP: the \$25 non-refundable registration fee MUST be paid within 24 hours of initial registration. This \$25 fee is applied to each child you register in the program. Payment for day camp weeks is due two weeks prior to the start of the week registered for.

Additional Information on Day Camp Registration:

Goulds Rec strives to be as fair as possible when it comes to registering for programs. We want to ensure that every family has a fair opportunity to register for this wonderful program. We believe in the first come first serve policy and will continue to follow this format. Parents/guardians can only register their own child(ren) for our day camp program. A parent/guardian under their on-line registration, CANNOT register a child from a different family/household. If it is noticed that this has taken place, registration for the child not within your family/household will become void. Goulds Rec staff have no access to bypass the on-line system and we have no control over who gains access first to our on-line system. Our day camp program is extremely popular with more than 100 families trying to get one of our limited spots for camp at the exact same time. With the Eventbrite system, there is no cart. The time running at the top is **NOT** an indication of how much time you have to "check out". It is simply the time you have access to the on-line registration system. It is a very trusted system and the process simply comes down to how fast you can complete the registration. You may have a week checked and when you go to register, it may no longer be available, as someone else may have clicked "register" before you. We understand that this can be very frustrating. We strongly recommend you check yes to the wait list.

Additional Day Camp Information

Day Camp and Sports Programs: If your child is registered for day camp and they also want to take part in our day time sports programs, our counselors will walk your child to the program and bring them back to day camp during their weeks at camp!!! If your child is registered in 5 or more weeks of day camp, you will get a \$10 discount on sports registration! Please note that if the sport program session overlaps with a day camp field trip, your child will have to go on the field trip and miss their sport session.

How to get the MOST accurate information about Goulds Rec programming:

We strongly advise you to contact Goulds Rec directly (gouldsrecinfo@gmail.com; 745-7575) if you have any questions or concerns. We have noticed through certain social media groups that misinformation has been given. The easiest way to get the most accurate and factual information would be to contact us directly. We also kindly ask that you refrain from sending private messages to staff on their personal accounts.

Goulds Rec Refund Policy:

All refunds for Goulds Rec programs will be subject to a \$15 administration fee. Full refunds will only be issued if Goulds Rec cancels a program/event. Refunds will only be issued during the first 2 weeks of 8+ week programs and during the first week of 4-7 week programs. Refunds will not be issued for 2-3 week programs or for special events. Day Camp requires a two-week notice (2 weeks prior to the week(s) cancelling) to cancel.
