Dear Participant,

Thank you for your interest in being a part of Showtime At The View Community Talent Show, the main fundraiser for the Mountain View High School PTSA. The talent show is open to all ages from 4-99 years and all talents from actors and dancers to drummers and singers! The Talent Show Committee is excited to provide this fun, engaging, and worthwhile experience **February 22, 2020 @ 2pm**, for the community!

Acts are selected by an audition process. Auditioning for the show does not guarantee a performer slot. A second audition will be held at **Mountain View High School in the Performing Arts Center on January 28, 2020, 6pm sharp. Please arrive by 5:45pm. All participants are expected to arrive in the same attire that is planned for the Talent Show. Also, there is a mandatory participant meeting on February 6 at Mountain View High School.** As a Talent Show participant, you will first need to complete the requirements for registration. All information will be communicated to performers via email. Please make sure to include an email address that you check regularly on your audition form. Registration will be considered complete when you have submitted all completed forms. You may submit the forms to [mvptsa@gmail.com](mailto:mvptsa@gmail.com). In order to audition for the show, performers **MUST** prepare the following checklist:

- A. Complete the Talent Show Audition Form and have it ready to turn in at the time of your audition. You will not be able to audition until you have completed this form.
- B. On the day of your audition, be ready to perform a full one to two minutes of your act.
  - Make sure to have all necessary items for your act as well as your COMPLETED audition form ready to go.
  - Please dress in day of Talent Show attire and dress to impress!
  - Please note that auditions may run short or long.
  - If you plan to audition with a backing track, please bring in an mp3 device (ex. cell phone, mp3 player)
- C. Before you decide to audition, please make sure that you are ready to commit to the show and to the expectations required of all performers. You are able to perform on the performance dates on Friday evening, February 21 or Saturday, February 22, 2020.

Further information regarding the show and related events will be available on our website, Facebook, through school announcements, and via email. In the meantime, good luck as you prepare and welcome to the Showtime at the View family!

## Rules & Release - Form A (page 1)

**\*\*Note: You will keep this page for your reference and sign & return the next page**

In order to insure the integrity of the Showtime at the View Talent Show & Program, ALL participants and their parent/guardian (if applicable) must agree to and submit the Rules & Release Form below.

1. All participants must meet eligibility requirements and be in good standing with their appropriate school (if applicable).
2. Judges' decisions are final! Talking with the Judges before, during, or after the talent show is prohibited. If any family, friend, or the participant is caught violating this rule, the participant will be disqualified and forfeiture of any and all awards received.
3. Good sportsmanship is required at all times. Failure to show good sportsmanship (including any family or friend of the participant) will result in disqualification of the participant without refund and forfeiture of any and all awards received. This rule applies before, during and after the talent show and includes Twitter, Facebook, Instagram and all other social media sites.
4. There is no entry fee for participants. **However, participants are required to sell a minimum of 5 tickets.** All ticket sales are non-refundable.
5. Showtime at the View and the PTSA reserve the right to refuse admittance at the talent show to anyone that we feel may be a security risk. This includes rehearsals and volunteer opportunities.
6. Showtime at the View and the PTSA are not responsible for loss due to injury incurred at, or in travel to and from the talent show. We are not responsible for any thefts that may occur.
7. Showtime at the View and the PTSA require high moral standards and adhere to the Gwinnett County School Board's "Student Code of Conduct"; therefore any participant or winner caught engaged in such acts, as drinking alcohol, taking drugs, smoking, foul language, bullying, etc., will be immediately disqualified at the discretion of the Mountain View High School PTSA, Administration and/or Director.
8. In keeping with the Showtime at the Views' policies, any person participating in the talent show must monitor their social networks, such as Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, etc., and any email accounts to be sure that they are within high moral standards. This will include posts and pictures from others on your pages and/or any pictures and posts from the participant or winner on their own page or others' pages. Any participant or winner can be immediately disqualified at the discretion of the Mountain View High School PTSA, Administration and/or Director.
9. Permission is granted to Showtime at the Views, the Mountain View High School PTSA and Mountain View High School to use, reproduce, and/or publish photographs and/or video that may pertain to me – including my image, likeness and/or voice without compensation.
