Greetings Marines, Corpsmen

As I sit here waiting for SPRING and reviewing the department roster, I find the department has done well in getting members to renew their memberships. At present time the Department of Kansas stands at 406 current members in good standing and 15 members that remain overdue. By upgrading the roster for the detachments, Paymasters removed members that were one or more years in the rears from rosters taking the Department of Kansas from a total of 323 paid up members with 55 overdue, a net gain of 83 members. GREAT job Paymasters. Nationwide life members are increasing in numbers, Kansas currently has 204 Life members. This combined with the overdue members is causing a cash flow problem for National, a solution to this problem would also help the department, that being we need to recruit new members and keep them current.
