- The average age of our farmers is 57.6 years.
- One Farmer/Rancher provides food and fiber for himself and 164 other people (as of 2015).
- There are approximately 479 farms in Boone County.
- Boone County farmers harvested 11,321,000 bushels of corn and 2,171,000 bushels of soybeans in 2017.
- In 2017, Boone County farmers raised an estimated 600 head of Beef Cows and 1,800 head of Milk Cows with a total head of all cattle and calves of 6,100.
- In 2017, Boone County ranked 10th for the number of milk cows in the state and Winnebago county ranked 9th.


