

## RECREATION COMMITTEE

**FLAG SALUTE:** led by Chairwoman Susan Rude at 7:15 PM.

**STATEMENT:** Chairwoman S. Rude stated the meeting is being held in compliance with the provisions of P.L. 1975, Ch. 231, 4 & 13 of the Sunshine Law and that adequate notice of said meeting has been published in the New Jersey Herald being the Daily & Sunday editions as to time, place, and date, and is posted in the usual locations of posted notices in the municipal building.

**MINUTES: May 16, 2012**

A **MOTION** was made by E. Junior and seconded by Vice Chairman J. Cutler, with all members in favor, to approve the April 25, 2012 minutes.

### **PRIORITY DISCUSSION LIST**

1. **Jazz Band at the Park: Friday, July 27-** Chairwoman S. Rude stated the Jazz band will be performing at the pavilion on Friday, July 27<sup>th</sup>. She asked Secretary V. Galizia what time the band would be performing and if it was being advertised. Secretary V. Galizia responded the event is posted on the website and will be on the board in front of the municipal Building closer to the event date as well as in the NJ Herald, Channel 10, and WSUS. D. Coranoto stated the event starts at 6:30 PM but to check with Jarred Mathis, head of the Jazz Band, on the time.
2. **Movies in Motion summer date:** Chairwoman S. Rude asked the Committee members if they feel there should be a summer date for the Movies in Motion or to wait until the end of September so flyers can be sent to McKeown School. She stated there wasn't a great turnout last summer because not everyone noticed the advertising; the best way to get the information out there is through the school newsletters. Also, the School may be used as a rain facility if the weather is bad that evening. The Committee agreed to wait until September to have the Movies in Motion with a tentative date of Friday, September 21<sup>st</sup>, if available. Secretary V. Galizia will contact Movies in Motion to see if the date is available and what the top 5 movies are. She will also contact McKeown School to see if the Cafeteria or Gym may be used that evening if the

weather is bad. The members will be contacted through email and telephone to hear the options and vote.

3. **No meetings in July & August:** Chairwoman S. Rude reminded the members in attendance that there will be no meetings in July & August as decided at January's reorganization meeting. The next regularly scheduled meeting is September 26, 2012.
4. **Hampton Township Field of Dreams Car, Truck and Motorcycle Show- Saturday, October 13, 2012:** Chairwoman S. Rude stated the car show is to be on Saturday, October 13<sup>th</sup> at Hampton Park from 11:00 AM – 4:00 PM. Chairwoman S. Rude asked Secretary V. Galizia if there were any vendors for the event yet. Secretary V. Galizia responded that Dairy Swirl in Vernon and Sally Abruzzo from Tastefully Simple are interested in being vendors for the day. She stated she made a vendor application and has posted it on the website but wanted to know if it should be \$25.00 like Hampton Day or a different price. The Committee members agreed \$25.00 is a fair price to pay to be a vendor for the day.

D. Coranoto asked what type of advertising is being done for the event. Secretary V. Galizia stated the event has been on the website, she created a poster which is in the foyer to the Municipal Building and will be going to Kittatinny High School in September, it's on the NJ Mopar Group's webpage, njcarshow.com, thewandererscarclub.com, on The Township Journal, Chris DeVries will be handing out flyers at the car shows he attends as well as at the Chatterbox. It will also be advertised on WSUS and Channel 10 closer to the event. Chairwoman S. Rude asked Secretary V. Galizia to look into the pricing of 15 plastic signs for the roadway. D. Coranoto stated he felt more advertising should be done soon to get people thinking about it.

Chairwoman S. Rude stated the Recreation Committee will be running the pavilion at the event and to have the sports teams each do an hour shift. She stated she thinks four people should be in the kitchen at all times: 3 from sports teams and 1 from the Recreation Committee.

1. **Thank you letter from Kittatinny Little League to DPW Manager Dan Bayles:** Chairwoman S. Rude stated John Wollehber from the Kittatinny Little League wrote a thank you letter to DPW Manager Dan Bayles for his departments efforts to prep and maintain the fields for the year.
2. **Roman Oben Flag Football Program:** Chairwoman S. Rude stated Roman does flag football camps. Everything from the marketing to the equipment is covered by his program; the only thing the township would have to do is supply the space.
