“More extreme wet, dry seasons on the horizon in California”

Government Technology – July 10, 2019

California will get shorter bursts of more intense rainfall as the climate warms, a new study by researchers at Scripps Institution of Oceanography suggests.

The study, “Precipitation regime change in Western North America: The role of

atmospheric rivers”, was published Tuesday in the Journal of Nature Scientific Reports. It projects that California will face greater extremes of wet and dry seasons, with rainy periods dominated by atmospheric rivers – powerful plumes of airborne moisture that drench the West Coast.
