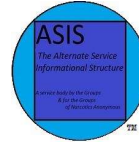


Alternate Service Informational Structure for NA ***~Meeting List~***

The Alternate Service Informational Structure (ASIS) is a service structure created by NA Groups who adhere to the principle of service directed by the Groups without conceptual renegotiation of our Traditions. We do not use concepts, but instead rely directly on the Traditions and trust the Groups to direct those services. We value "trusted service", rather than "effective leadership". In short, the Groups drive the services, not the other way around. The structure itself is loosely defined and takes shape according to the will of the Groups as they create the services they direct. We come together to share information and coordinate with one another on issues that relate to NA as a whole through the annual Fellowship Service Conference (FSC). The Anonymi Foundation (AF) is the entity we use to file copyrights on behalf of the NA Groups who direct ASIS through the FSC. Literature is not held in trust, but copyrighted directly to the Groups of Narcotics Anonymous. The Anonymi Foundation will never take independent legal action without the direction of the NA Groups who create & direct the FSC, nor is the AF intended to protect NA literature from the members and Groups who own it.



The 12 Traditions of Narcotics Anonymous

1. Our common welfare should come first; personal recovery depends on N.A. Unity.
2. For our Group purpose there is one ultimate authority – a loving God as He may express Himself in our Group conscience; our leaders are but trusted servants, they do not govern.
3. The only requirement for membership is a desire to stop using.
4. Each Group should be autonomous, except in matters affecting other Groups, or N.A., as a whole.
5. Each Group has but one primary purpose – to carry the message to the addict who still suffers.
6. An N.A. Group ought never endorse, finance, or lend the N.A. name to any related facility or outside enterprise, lest problems of money, property or prestige divert us from our primary purpose.
7. Every N.A. Group ought to be fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions.
8. Narcotics Anonymous should remain forever nonprofessional, but our service centers may employ special workers.
9. N.A., as such, ought never be organized; but we may create service boards or committees directly responsible to those they serve.
10. N.A. has no opinion on outside issues; hence the N.A. name ought never to be drawn into public controversy.
11. Our public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio and films.
12. Anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all our Traditions, ever reminding us to place principles before personalities.

The Twelve Steps of Narcotics Anonymous

1. We admitted that we were powerless over our addiction, that our lives had become unmanageable.
2. We came to believe that a Power greater than ourselves could restore us to sanity.
3. We made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God as we understood Him.
4. We made a searching and fearless moral inventory of ourselves.
5. We admitted to God, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs.
6. We were entirely ready to have God remove all these defects of character.
7. We humbly asked Him to remove our shortcomings.
8. We made a list of all persons we had harmed, and became willing to make amends to them all.
9. We made direct amends to such people wherever possible, except when to do so would injure them or others.
10. We continued to take personal inventory, and when we were wrong promptly admitted it.
11. We sought through prayer and meditation to improve our conscious contact with God as we understood Him, praying only for knowledge of His will for us and the power to carry that out.
12. Having had a spiritual awakening as a result of those steps, we tried to carry this message to addicts, and to practice these principles in all our affairs.
