

EQUITATION DIVISIONS & CLASSES

All divisions judged on position and control of mount.

Leadline - May split into age groups: 3 Years & Under, 4-6 Years Old

Walk-Trot - Open to all riders of any age who have not yet cantered in a horse show. May cross enter into any WT class throughout the show.

Short Stirrup Equitation - Riders 12 yrs and under, to jump crossrails.

Beginner Rider Equitation - Open to riders of any age in their first or second year of showing, to jump crossrails.

Junior Equitation - Open to junior riders. Fences 2' for ponies, 2'6" for horses.

Low Adult Equitation - Open to Adult Amateur riders, fences 2'.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

All divisions to be judged on manners, performance and way of going.

Short Stirrup Hunter - Riders 12 yrs and under. To show over crossrails up to 18".

Modified Hunter - Open to horses or ponies of any age, all riders. May cross enter into any division where the fences are 2' or lower. No oxers.

Low Children's Hunter - Open to Junior riders on ponies. Judged on mount. All ponies jump 2', horses to jump 2'6". May not cross enter into the Children's Hunter. Division will be split if there are a minimum of 3 entries in each section.

Low Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to Adult Amateur riders. All to jump 2'6". May not cross enter into Adult Amateur Hunter.

Children's Hunter - Open to junior riders. Judged on mount. May not cross enter into Pre-Children's Hunter. Horses 2'9", Large ponies 2'6", Small/Medium ponies 2'.

Adult Amateur Hunter - Open to Adult Amateur riders. Judged on mount. All to jump 2'9". May not cross enter into Low Adult Amateur Hunter.

Developing Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their first year of showing regardless of age. Trotting anywhere on course not to be penalized, to jump crossrails with flower box ground lines.

Baby Green Hunter - Open to horses and ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Ponies all to jump 2'. Horses to jump 2'3". Trotting on corners not to be penalized.

Low Hunter - Open to horses of any age, all riders. Fences 2'6".

Thoroughbred Hunter - Open to registered or non-registered Thoroughbreds, all riders. Fences 2'3".

PLEASURE DIVISION

To be judged on manners and performance.

Pleasure Horse or Pony - Open to all, adults may show ponies, suitability to count. May be asked simple tasks such as halt, stand or back to demonstrate manners and rideability. Division will be split into pony and horse sections if there are three or more entries in each section. Final class to be judged WTC and to jump two fences: ponies 2', horses 2'3".

All divisions will pin a Champion & Reserve Champion.

ENTRIES

\$20.00 per class

Entries will close at 3 pm the day before the show, no walk-in post entries will be allowed on the show day. Changes to an existing entry will be permitted.

SCHOOLING

Go to www.horseshowing.com on the show day to see the schooling schedule and approximate show times.

The show ring will be open on the morning of the show from 7:00 am to 7:45 am, and at appropriate breaks between divisions.

A \$20.00 Grounds Fee will be charged to each account.

Schooling sessions will be supervised by show staff.

REFRESHMENTS

Complementary grab-n-go coffee & donuts will be available throughout the morning, and bottled water will be available throughout the day.

Please pack your own food, snacks and refreshments, as no food service will be on site.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The Horse Show Committee, the Horse Show organizers, WyndSOR Farm or property owners will not be responsible for any damage, injury or loss to persons, horse/pony or property of any exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
2. Classes for juniors will be limited to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to 12/1/2020.
3. ASTM approved helmets must be worn when mounted. Masks or face coverings must be worn at any time except when mounted.
4. The decision of a judge is final.
5. No martingales to be worn in flat classes.
6. Refer to the websites of each High Score Association for rules of compliance. It is each exhibitor's responsibility to understand the point eligibility and specifications of the program in which they compete.
7. Divisions will consist of two classes over fences and one under saddle or flat class unless otherwise stated.
8. Accounts payable by cash, check or credit card. Make checks payable to: Briarwood Farm, credit card payments will incur a 3% service charge.
9. Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes or relocate classes to expedite the schedule. Management also reserves the right to close entries as necessary. Please pre-enter to avoid any disappointment!

Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 22 (Morgantown). Follow Route 10 South. At the stop sign, turn left onto Route 23. The farm is 6.5 miles on the right.

From PA Tnpk Philadelphia:

Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 23 (Downingtown). Follow Route 100 North to Route 401 West. Turn right onto Route 345, at the stop sign turn right onto Route 23. The farm is 1 mile on the right.

From Route 422:

Take Route 100 South towards West Chester. Turn right onto Route 23. The farm is 5 miles on the left.

From Rt. 78:

Take Rt. 78 to Route 100 South to turn right onto Route 23. The farm is 5 miles on the left.
