the amount of sulfate discharge averaged at each discharger and found different conclusions.

“To our surprise, when we mapped the data we could see that in all of Minnesota the only sulfate issues that would be required to be addressed are in the Mississippi River and some waters on the Iron Range,” Watkins stated.

Suddenly the list of affected dischargers shrunk dramatically.

Even if the sulfate standard had been changed, Watkins says the effect would have been about the same if the MPCA enforced the current standard, leaving little financial hardship for municipalities.

“The fact is where the problem is doesn't change, and it is sad that polluting companies seem to say they can't afford to comply with the Clean Water Act when we have looked at their Security and Exchange filings and it's clear that's not the truth,” said Watkins.

The MCT report says the biggest sulfate polluters are Minnesota Power at their Boswell and Laskin energy plants, followed by ten taconite mining operations.

A review of 140 MPCA permits on file revealed data that Watkins called shocking.

“The MPCA much more closely regulates small com-

munity wastewater systems than electric utilities and mines, and only slightly more than ten percent of electric utility and mine permits are up to date,” Watkins stated.

Part of the TWRTF, Schuldt also served on the wild rice advisory board that the MPCA had in place during the revision process, and has been involved in wild rice research, restoration and management for more than 20 years.

“We are the experts, we have qualified staff and can give you the data for appropriate recommendations, we want our peers in state and federal agencies to act like we are, indeed, peers,” stated Schuldt.

The equation-based approach that the MPCA proposed with its most recent set of revisions relied on the theory that each waterbody could have different standards based on the chemical makeup of the soil. The theory is that more iron in the soil is protective of wild rice when sulfide is present.

Schuldt says the science does not uphold that theory.

“I have never in my life seen ecological experimental data so clear cut, saying that the sulfate number that affects wild rice growth is dependent on soil conditions is just not so, we don't place any stock in those statements. The MPCA assumption that iron is protective has been refuted,” said Schuldt.
