U.S.ARMY Comrades,

<u>Parking Lot Repaying</u> <u>Fundraiser</u>: We have raised about a third of the \$30,000 needed to pay off

this project which the Post could no longer avoid. Please get your donation check in to: Sid GAUNA, our Finance Officer ASAP.

Friday Night Kitchen Obligation: Four times a month, the Post operates the kitchen. Virtually the SAME people VOLUNTARILY do the work (cooking the steaks, collecting the money, delivering the meals, washing the dishes, & cleaning up afterwards) EVERY month. That's not right! We cannot expect Sid to always cook the steaks. EVE-RY MEMBER, except those physically unable, MUST perform kitchen duty at least ONCE PER YEAR. If all of us did that, just one Friday per year, we would have the kitchen covered. Please contact Commander Martinez or myself and VOL-UNTEER now. I will be pushing hard for this all year and encourage all the Post officers to do the same.

Buddy Checks: The Legion National Commander has proposed that we create a buddy system to keep in contact with Post members that we never hear from. I will be pushing our Post Executive Board to organize a system where more active members are assigned to contact maybe 5 members who we never hear from each month just to check on their health and encourage their participation.

Post Revenue Generation Ideas: Comrades, the Post building is old. It leaks badly and needs new windows and a roof, restrooms, plumbing, etc.. We MUST find creative ways to generate major funds to pay for repairs. Your annual dues and our modest profit from Friday nights do not finance this. We must quickly do more to generate significant funds. At our February 14 meeting, I presented 13 reasonable ideas including 2 MAJOR fundraising drives every year, expanding our donations campaign into the local community, service organizations, and businesses. Please encourage your Post officers to push this, give them reasonable ideas for revenue generation, and get yourself involved too.






