For the past 23 years, Pi Theta Omega has offered scholarships to students in the Morris County area.

Eligibility Criteria:

- ❖ Be of African-American descent
- Applicant must be a high school senior and reside or go to school in Morris County
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- ❖ Acceptance to a four-year Historically Black College or University (HBCU)
- Attendance at the Chapter's Scholarship Awards Presentation Event scheduled for Saturday, June 18, 2016

In order to be considered for the Marjorie M. Herbert HBCU Scholarship, the completed application, all recommendations, and transcript must be postmarked **by April 15, 2016**. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
