#### **Tournament News**

#### Two-Man, 4-Club Red Tees

We had a low turnout of 60 players this year, so we cut the field to three flights. I was a bit surprised since this format has normally drawn more players each year. Last year we had 75. We had two-man teams in three flights and used both courses. A flight was on Chino Creek and B&C flight were on Butterfield Stage. Winners included the teams of Mike Cole/ Kirk Dancses in the A Flight with a score of 56. The B Flight team with a score of 55 was Rich Lizarraga/Dennis Robinson. Winning C flight with a very nice 57 was the team Don Yurgans/ Larry LaBonte.

The scorecards were much better this year since I included the dots. This also made it a lot easier to audit. Thanks to Kevin for his support on the scoreboard and help with the results. When you talk with him please let him know how much we appreciate the help and support he gives to the El Prado Mens Club.

Your suggestions are always welcome. All ideas will be discussed and considered by the EPMC Board and in consideration of the Golf Course as the case may be. We like to discuss new ideas and see if we can make them a part of our club and tournaments.

**The Club Championship** is our next tournament to be held September 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup>. Our tournament year has been leading up to this major one and, if you win, you carry the title and bragging rights for the entire year. Plus, the low gross winner is entitled to go to the SCGA Tournament of Champions representing El Prado Mens Club with entry fee complements of the club. The low net flight champion will also be sponsored for entry by the club but will have to pay their own entry fees. Our 2017 El Prado Men's Club Champion was Brian Dancses (142), and our lowest - low net flight champion was Louis Washington (135).

Eligibility: 3 Tournaments or 9 Skins games or a combination of both (3 skins = 1 tournament)
Reminders: The Club Championship is a two-day event. I will only consider pairing requests on the first day. The second day pairings are set by your first day positions/ranking.

A Flt – Blue tees, B Flt – Blue/White tees, C & D Flt White tees.

Only all Blue Tees to be considered for the Gross Club Championship. - This option is open to anyone, just let me know ahead of time so I can set it up.)

Get your Club Championship entry in early in order to secure any tee time requests.
