1. The Probation Officer must identify the candidate as a probationer in good standing with Probation and the Court.
2. Eligible expenses are limited to tuition, books/related supplies, parking or transit fees and student health insurance.
3. All awards will be paid directly to the educational institution. No payment will be made to the student for previously incurred educational expenses.
4. A previous scholarship award winner may reapply for subsequent scholarships provided they maintain a 2.0 GPA and all other scholarship requirements have been maintained.
5. Scholarships are granted based on availability of funds by the VIP Scholarship Committee.
6. Awards will be granted twice per year, at the end of May and the end of November.

1. Why do you deserve this scholarship?
2. What are your future career goals?
3. How has your period of probation influenced your life?

Additional items to attach to your application:

1. The applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from school or a reputable personal reference (minister, mentor, etc.)
2. Proof of acceptance to the school or program. Previous scholarship recipients should provide proof of grades.
3. Submit proof that court ordered restitution has been addressed or paid in full.
