2014 Veteran's Day Parade Participant Rules

GIVE AWAYS

NOTHING, ABSOLUTELY NOTHING (candy, beads etc) may be thrown during the parade by a parade entry. If participants do not follow this rule, the entry will be pulled immediately from the parade route and will forfeit any rights to future participation. This Veterans Day Parade is done out of respect for those who have served our country and those who did not return home. Flags or tokens of patriotism may be passed out by those walking.

HORSES AND OTHER ANIMALS

Animal participants must wear animal diapers. Entries with animals accept responsibility for cleaning up the staging area and parade route, if necessary. Failure to comply with this very reasonable request may result in being pulled from the parade line-up and/or not being allowed to participate in future parades.

PARADE FLOW

FLOAT GUIDELINES

Float trailers cannot exceed 45 feet in length or 8 feet in width. The Council assumes no liability for floats that are damaged in any way. Floats must be equipped with side rails at least 18 inches high, and a walker at each of the four corners of the float. Only experienced drivers may pull floats. The driver pulling the float is the responsibility of the float organization.

CHILDREN

It is the responsibility of organizations with children to maintain control of the children and the organization is responsible for their safety.

CHECK IN

All participants must check in between 7 a.m. & 8:30 a.m. on the day of the parade. They will be issued a line up number and given additional instructions pertaining to the lineup.

PLEASE NOTE – For 2014, the Parade will line up on Main Street ONLY!

I have read the above rules and understand that failing to abide by them will disqualify this organization from participating in the future.
