

Director Barry J. Wicklow, Ph.D. is Emeritus Professor of Biology at Saint Anselm College where he taught Aquatic Ecology and Conservation Biology and served as the director of the Environmental Science Program. He dedicates his scholarly research to understanding the biology of and threats to rare and imperiled species. In 2002 he received the college's Distinguished Faculty Award. Early in his career he served as president of an Audubon Society of NH chapter and on the board of directors of the Piscataquog Land Conservancy, later as vice president. In 2007 he was awarded the statewide "Conservationist of the Year" (Tudor Richard's Award) by the Audubon Society of NH. He also received the Piscataquog Land Conservancy's Gordon A. Russell Conservation Award. He chairs the conservation committee for the Frankestown Land Trust.
