

### 13. Bev Stellges HALF LOG CABIN QUILT

Quilt center: 60" x 60" **without** borders

**FABRIC:** Fabric amounts given below are sufficient for making the center of this quilt and extra for use in the borders. Always be prepared with more fabric if you wish a larger border or quilt size.

Fabric amounts:

3 ½ yds. large floral focal print

½ yard of nine complementary fabrics for the logs.

1 ½ yard of complementary fabric for the small center square of each block

Supplies:

- rotary cutter
- rotary cutting board
- rulers (12", 24", etc.)
- iron and ironing board
- scissors
- straight pins
- sewing machine in working order (bring manual)
- bobbins
- thread
- extra sewing machine needles
- extension cords
- multi socket outlet
- seam ripper
- general sewing kit

**PREPARATION FOR CLASS:** Please cut your fabric according to the cutting directions attached.

Large floral focal print: Cut eighteen (18) 11" squares; then cut the squares on the diagonal to produce 36 large triangles. (Left over fabric will be used for a border)

Small center squares: cut thirty-six (36) 2 ½" squares. (Left over fabric will be used for a border/binding)

Nine complementary fabrics: Cut 2" strips from each fabric, across the width of the fabric.

Then cut each strip into these lengths:

3 ½", 5", 6 ½", 8", 9 ½", 11 ½". You will need 36 of each of these sizes

Label or bag your strips to keep organized!

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
