As you may know, our programs at Colby's Army (Operation Backpack, Fern's Organic Garden, Operation Job Training, and Therapeutic Riding and Equine Assisted Activities) serve children and adults with challenges such as homelessness, cerebral palsy, depression, developmental delay, post traumatic stress, autism, Downs syndrome, bullying, and more.

Our backpacks filled with street supplies give hope to men and women who are homeless. Our organic garden offers job training to adults with special needs and food for the homeless. And, our equine assisted activities and therapeutic riding teach responsibility, affect, respect, teamwork, time management, leadership, project management, and much more.

Recently, with the help of Heritage Bank, we were able to purchase the 54-acre farm in Ashland City that we have been leasing for the past three years. *The purchase opens up new sponsorship opportunities that will bring added visibility to sponsors and allow us to expand our programs.* Each sponsorship comes with signage in the area sponsored, and also on our sponsor wall.

Every sponsorship helps us teach needed skills to people with life challenges, which can lead to increased self-care, improved anger management and critical thinking skills, greater happiness, better physical fitness, and even jobs.
