Motion Murphy 2nd Couture to accept November 8, 2021 minutes as presented. 5 yes 0 no Motion Passed.

Guest Introduction and Citizens present: Jim Stickland, resident and Mike Walters from The Clinton Local

Jim Stickland expressed concerns about excessive target shooting on Clinton Macon Rd and inquired about an Ordinance. Supervisor advised Mr. Strickland to contact the Lenawee County Sheriff's Department.

Clerk mentioned Hazard Pay for past Election worker using ARPA, tabled for January.

February 23, 2022 Annual Meeting with the Lenawee County Road Commission.

Supervisor discussed Scan Snap purchase, tabled for January.

Discussed 45 acre parcel at end of Adams Drive in Bridgewater Township. Current Road is graded for only ten homes, the road must be upgraded to a class A road if additional home(s) are built. Purchasers has two alternative options obtain access off Trolan Drive or Sheridan Road.

Motion Murphy 2nd Couture for the Township to use ARPA monies for installation of Broadband in Deer Pointe through Midwest Energy and Communication with agreement stating costs along with 50% down and 50% upon completion. 5 yes 0 no Motion Passed.

Discussed Aten Cemetery on Allen Road. Currently the Township is paying to Riverside Cemetery Sexton to maintain. Supervisor will continue to pursue trying to find out who owns this private Cemetery.
