PRIVATE LESSONS:

*Private lessons are held on Fridays, and are arranged between you and your child's coach. They are extremely beneficial for preparing for competition or improving on a specific skill. **Please note that skaters in their first year on the intermediate session may have a private lesson with a coach, but are not eligible to skate the Friday night free skate session alone until their second year in intermediate. All other skaters may skate the Friday night free skate but must follow the code of conduct.** All lessons and money transactions are between you and the coach.*
