

Hardwood Hoops-Youth Eligibility Guidelines-Spring League 2017

There are two ways a player may be deemed eligible for a particular division. The first criteria to be used is age, if, a player does not meet the age requirement, then, the second criteria to be used is grade exception. Each team in the league is permitted a maximum of 3 players eligible by grade exceptions. Note: *Players in high school are not permitted to play in youth divisions regardless of age.

GUIDELINES USED TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY BY AGE:

<u>Division</u>	<u>Description</u>	<u>Born on or After</u>
10U	No older than 10 on August 31, 2017.	September 1, 2006
11U	No older than 11 on August 31, 2017.	September 1, 2005
12U	No older than 12 on August 31, 2017.	September 1, 2004
13U	No older than 13 on August 31, 2017.	September 1, 2003
*14U	No older than 14 on August 31, 2017.	September 1, 2002

GUIDELINES USED TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY BY PLAYER EXCEPTION

<u>Grade</u>	<u>Description</u>	<u>Born on or After</u>
10U/4 th Grade	No older than 11 on August 31, 2017.	September 1, 2005
11U/5 th Grade	No older than 12 on August 31, 2017.	September 1, 2004
12U/6 th Grade	No older than 13 on August 31, 2017.	September 1, 2003
13U/7 th Grade	No older than 14 on August 31, 2017.	September 1, 2002
*14U/8 th Grade	No older than 15 on August 31, 2017.	September 1, 2001
