

### Sabberwock's Origin and Regacy

The word "Jabberwock," was coined by Lewis Carroll, author of the famous children's classic, **Alice's Adventures in Wonderland (1865).** The sequel to this book is a mock-heroic tale called, "**Through the Looking-Glass**" (1872) which contains "**Jabberwocky**," a ballad of fantastic illogicality. Curious about the world behind the mirror, Alice climbs through the looking-glass and discovers a fascinating kingdom in which everything is reversed, just as reflections are reversed in a mirror. Jabberwocky, then connotes the whimsical, the absurd, the non-sensual and fantastic.

The **Jabberwock**, a traditional Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. scholarship fundraising endeavor, has been staged annually by hundreds of Delta chapters in communities throughout the United States for over eighty (80) years and for over 35 years in the Kansas City, Kansas area.

In 1925 Delta Sorors Marian Conover Hope and Lola Wilson Hayes conceived the **Jabberwock** as a means of generating funds for scholarships, and the first ever **Jabberwock** was presented that year in Boston, MA. The first ones, held in auditoriums, were theme-centered talent/variety shows with scholarship awards. Since that time, **Jabberwock** has become synonymous with Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. In 1971 the Kansas City Kansas Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. held its last **Jabberwock** program of the theme-centered talent/variety show. Presently, **Jabberwock** represents a six month scholarship program concluded with an evening of elegance and entertainment showcasing the gifts and talents of the selected participants.

In our chapter, the Contestants Committee continues to be the backbone of the "Jabberwock Experience." Each year members of Delta Sigma theta Sorority, Inc. spearhead educational, social, and public service activities to help broaden young ladies' horizons as we assist in preparing them for their next step in life. Over the years Jabberwock has changed its look; however, it has never changed its purpose.
