2017 in Revue

We started our work last year with Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him and He will direct your paths.'

As a Transition Team we were tasked with 5 areas to work through with the church family. In this year as a church we have learned and affirmed the following:

Connections – Faith Fellowship is a "1963 Baptist Faith and Message" Baptist Church that is affiliated with the Baptist General Convention of Texas (Texas Baptists), Grayson Baptist Association and the Southern Baptist Convention. Local organizations we support

include: Helping Hands, True Options Pregnancy Center, Grayson County Shelter and the Boys & Girls Club of Denison.

Leadership – Faith Fellowship is incorporated as a non-profit in the state of Texas, we have adopted a Constitution & Bylaws. A church handbook is in the works, current church policies (pool, wedding, facilities, nursery, transportation) have been reviewed, new policies written (ministry teams, extended session, code of conduct, conflict resolution, personnel) and have several groups working on policies for their areas of ministry (children, students, kitchen, finances, safety & security). Members have also been encouraged to individually look at our S.H.A.P. E, to discover how God has created us for His purposes.

Missions – Faith Fellowship has held a Ministry/Missions Fair and is in the process of learning where each church member fits in God's design for the church's ministry and missions.

History – The Transition Team is in the process of completing a Church Profile which includes a recap of our history as well as other information about our church organization. We have decided to combine the annual Everybody's Birthday Celebration with a 19th Anniversary Celebration Luncheon on February 11, 2018. Future - The Transition Team has worked with the BGCT Architecture Department to develop a realistic site plan for our future and specifically a Phase 1 design for expanding our current

worship space. As soon as we started hearing pulpit supplies we began listening to you share your hearts about the type of pastor and style of preaching that speaks to each of you. We are currently surveying everyone to learn what you believe our new pastor's priorities should be. With your input the Transition Team will complete the Pastor Profile, leaving the wrap up with Karl Fickling and Brother Bobby as the only major task remaining before we turn our
